### Behavior Expectations for Participants

#### *Show Appropriate behavior*

● Participants listen to the Ginew/Golden Eagle Program staff/volunteers and peers. Bullying, profane language, and physically aggressive behavior is not tolerated in our circle. As Golden Eagle/Sacred Leaders we strive to conduct ourselves appropriately and stand as role models for our community.

#### *Respect Property*

● Participants care for the property of the Minneapolis American Indian Center, which includes but is not limited to, Ginew/Golden Eagle vehicles, and other areas/sites designated for the program. As Golden Eagle/Sacred Leaders we strive to show respect for the program by taking the proper care of Ginew/Golden Eagle vehicles, and other areas/sites for the continuance of the program for generations to come.

## **Transportation Policies & Procedures**

### ***Daily Attendance & Ride List Phone Call***

● Participation attendance is conducted daily between 11:00am-3:00pm(or a hour before we pick up for groups, if different from our regular schedule). This phone call is for attendance and ride list purposes. It is important that the parent/guardian notify the Ginew/Golden Eagle staff via telephone call of any changes (new phone number, new address, pick up/drop off location/time, cancellation after confirmation, etc...). 612-879-1708 is our Main Line. If the participant is unreachable for attendance confirmation by 3:00pm daily then they will not be eligible for the ride list for group that day. It is vital that the participant has a working/updated telephone number that Ginew/Golden Eagle staff can contact to confirm daily attendance for the ride list.

### ***Permission to Contact Participant Directly***

### ***Parent/Guardian Afternoon Drop Off***

● Group begins at 5:15pm. If a parent/guardian is dropping off the participant before this time they must supervise their child inside the Minneapolis American Indian Center until group begins at 5:15pm with Ginew Golden Eagle Program staff present for supervision purposes. If a parent/guardian is dropping off the participant they must ensure that their child is under Ginew Golden Eagle Program staff supervision.

### ***Parent/Guardian Night Pick Up/Drop Off***

- A parent/guardian must be present 10 minutes prior to when the Ginew Golden Eagle Program staff departs for ride list drop offs in the community (Group ending times: 7:00pm Mondays & Tuesdays/8:00pm Wednesdays & Thursdays).
- As a parent/guardian, please be present for child's drop off at home (Please allow 1 hour for drop off times: 7:00pm-8:00pm Mondays & Tuesdays/8:00pm-9:00pm Wednesdays & Thursdays).
- If a parent/guardian is not home the Ginew Golden Eagle Program staff will initiate steps in resolving the issue while Ginew/Golden Eagle participant remains under Ginew/Golden Eagle Program staff supervision, which includes but is not limited to, contacting all emergency contacts listed for participant, waiting at residence in Ginew/Golden Eagle vehicle with participant until parent/guardian/emergency contact is reached, and continuously contacting the parent/guardian. In the case that no parent/guardian/emergency contact is reached the participant may be taken to St. Joseph's Home for Children at 1120 East 47th Street in Minneapolis.

### ***Designated Driver/Receiver***
